

Meat Goat Show and Sale FEBRUARY 15th, 2020

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. The Meat Goat Show will be held following the SD Sheep Producers Sheep Show. The sale will immediately follow the sheep.
- 2. Entries open to 2019 open doelings and 2017 and 2018 bred does or does with kids at side. If numbers are sufficient, separate classes will be assigned for fall and spring doelings.
- 3. Entries may be registered or un-registered meat goats, Doelings or Does.
- 4. Buck class will continue in 2020, all bucks must be registered and full blood.
- 5. All entries must be clean.

 An evaluation committee will be appointed to check the quality and fitting of the does to be sold. This committee will have the authority to disqualify any doe or buck that does not meet the above standards set by the committee.
- Health certificates by a licensed veterinarian must be given to the show committee at entry time. Out-ofstate animals must meet South Dakota state requirements.
- 7. Entry fee is \$10.00 per head plus a 5% commission to cover all sale expenses. A 5% commission will be assessed for no sales based on the closing bid.
- 8. Papers on registered animals must be transferred to the buyer within 60 days from the sale.
- 9. Animals may be brought to the show after 10:00 a.m. on Friday, February 14th and before 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, February 15th.
- 10. Entries are due by January 15th. Substitutions will be allowed. Final pedigree information due January 15th.
- 11. No bred does older than 2017 will be accepted.
- 12. Scrapie tags are required for all does or bucks consigned to the sale.
- 13. Wood shavings provided.
